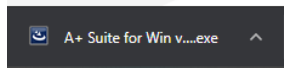

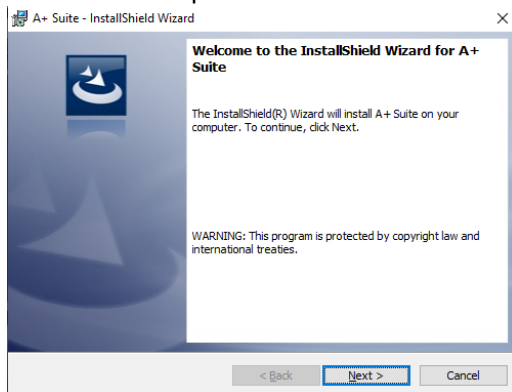

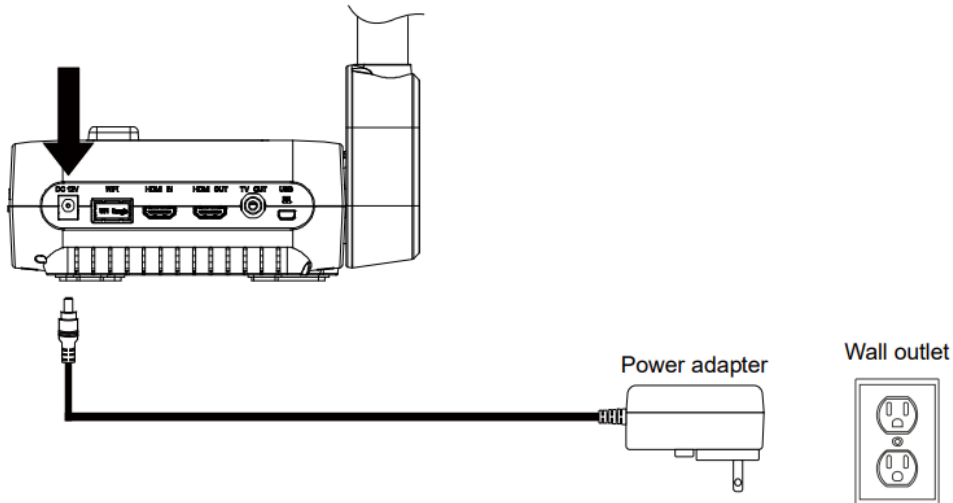

Connecting the Power

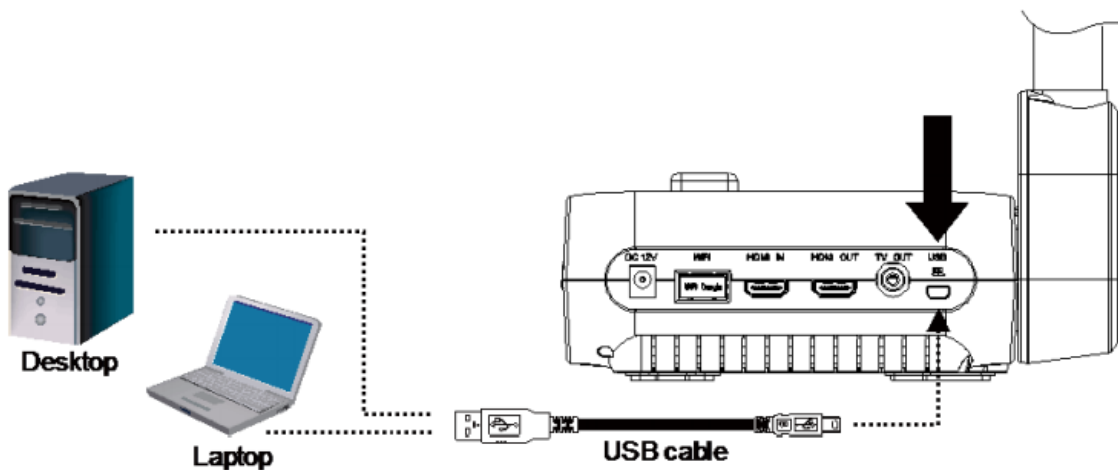
Connect the power adapter (12V) to a standard 100V~240V AC power outlet. Press  button to go into standby mode once the power is connected. Press  again to boot up the machine.



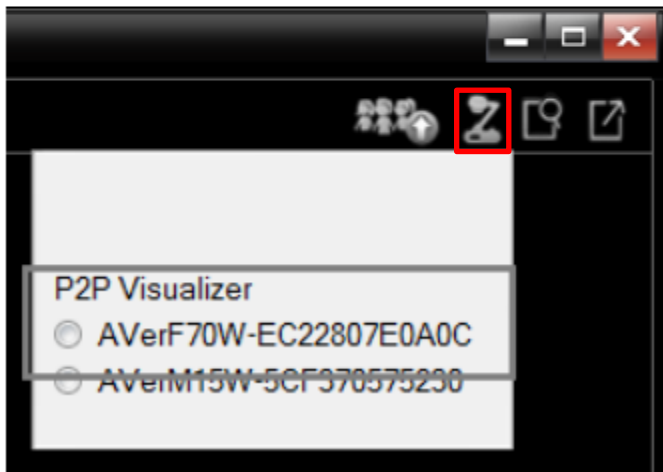
5. Locate a USB port on your computer and connect your camera to it via USB cable that is included

Locate the USB port of the computer or laptop and connect it to the PC port of the AVerVision F70W.



6. Select the visualizer icon on the top right of the Sphere2 software and select your camera



7. You are now connected to your AVer document camera and can begin teaching!

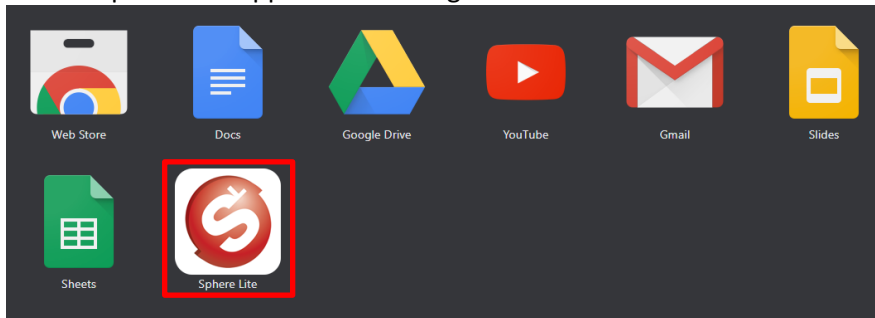

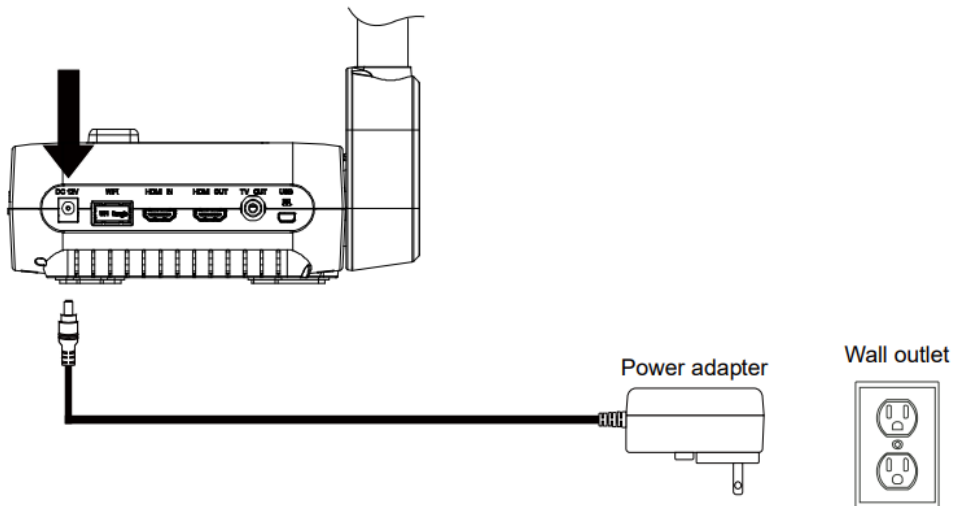

Connecting the Power

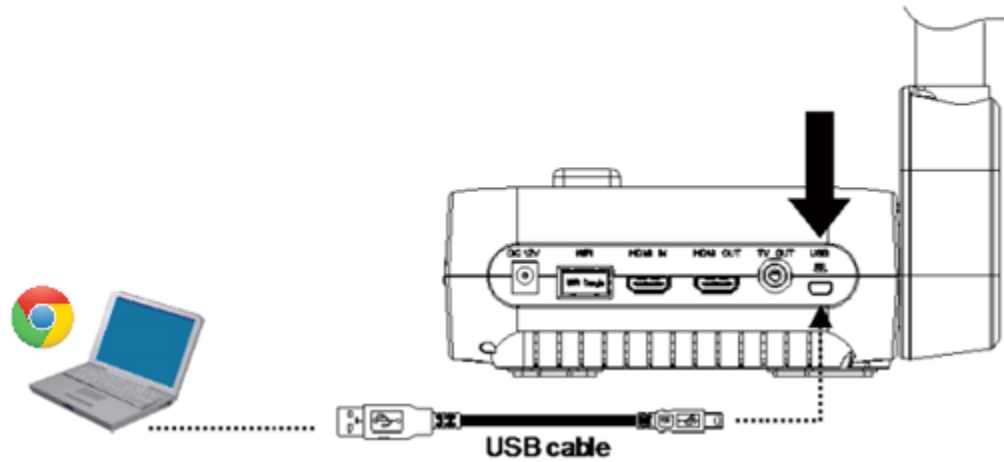

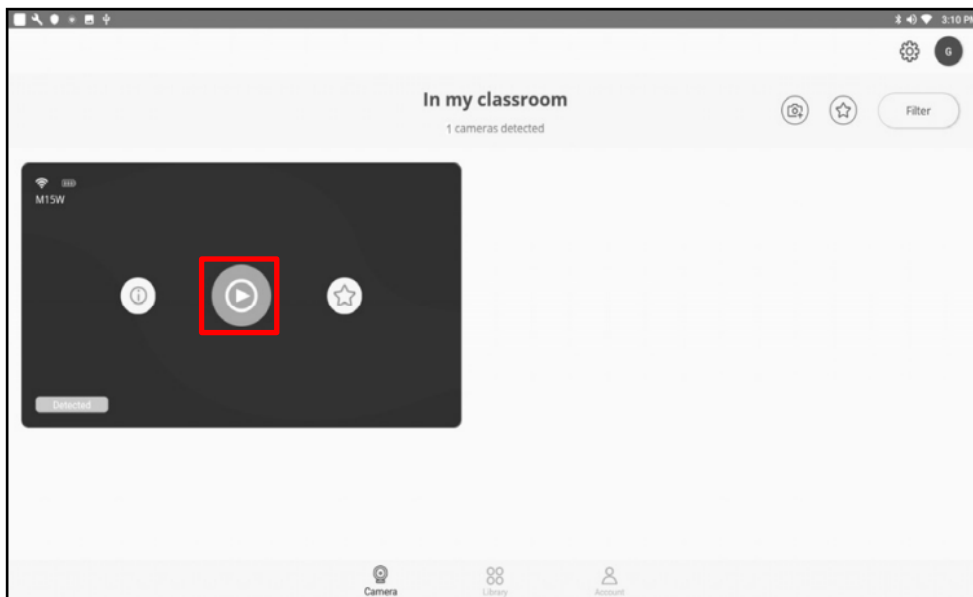

Note: For M15W/M70W users, please make sure WiFi is turned off when trying to do a USB connection

8. The connected visualizer will appear within the AVerTouch software. Click the play icon to connect to the camera

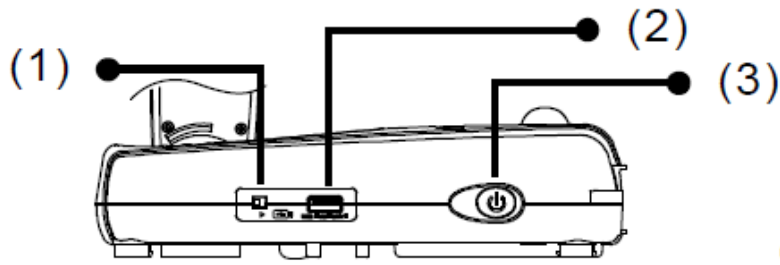

Using your AVer Document Camera with other platforms (Zoom, Skype, Google Hangout).

Note: Only document cameras that are UVC/UAC compatible will work (refer to table on first page). If your AVer document camera is NOT UVC compatible, please follow “Upgrade your VGA Doc Cam to USB” guide on page 17.



Open up your software of choice and connect your AVer document camera to your computer via USB cable. Select your AVer document camera as your visualizer and you are successfully connected!

Upgrade your VGA Doc Cam to USB:

This guide is for older VGA document cameras that are not UVC compatible. It will allow you to connect your camera to your PC and utilize your old document camera with other video applications (Zoom, Skype, Google Hangout).

Note: This guide is for video only and does not work for converting audio. It may not work with older cameras with VGA resolution that cannot reach 1024x768. AVer does not guarantee that this solution will work 100% but can be utilized as a template to temporarily upgrade older cameras with USB output.

Supported Resolutions: 1024x768, 1280x720 to 1920x1080

Equipment needed:

- VGA to HDMI converter: about \$9.99 on Amazon

- HDMI to USB converter: about \$15-\$20 / pc

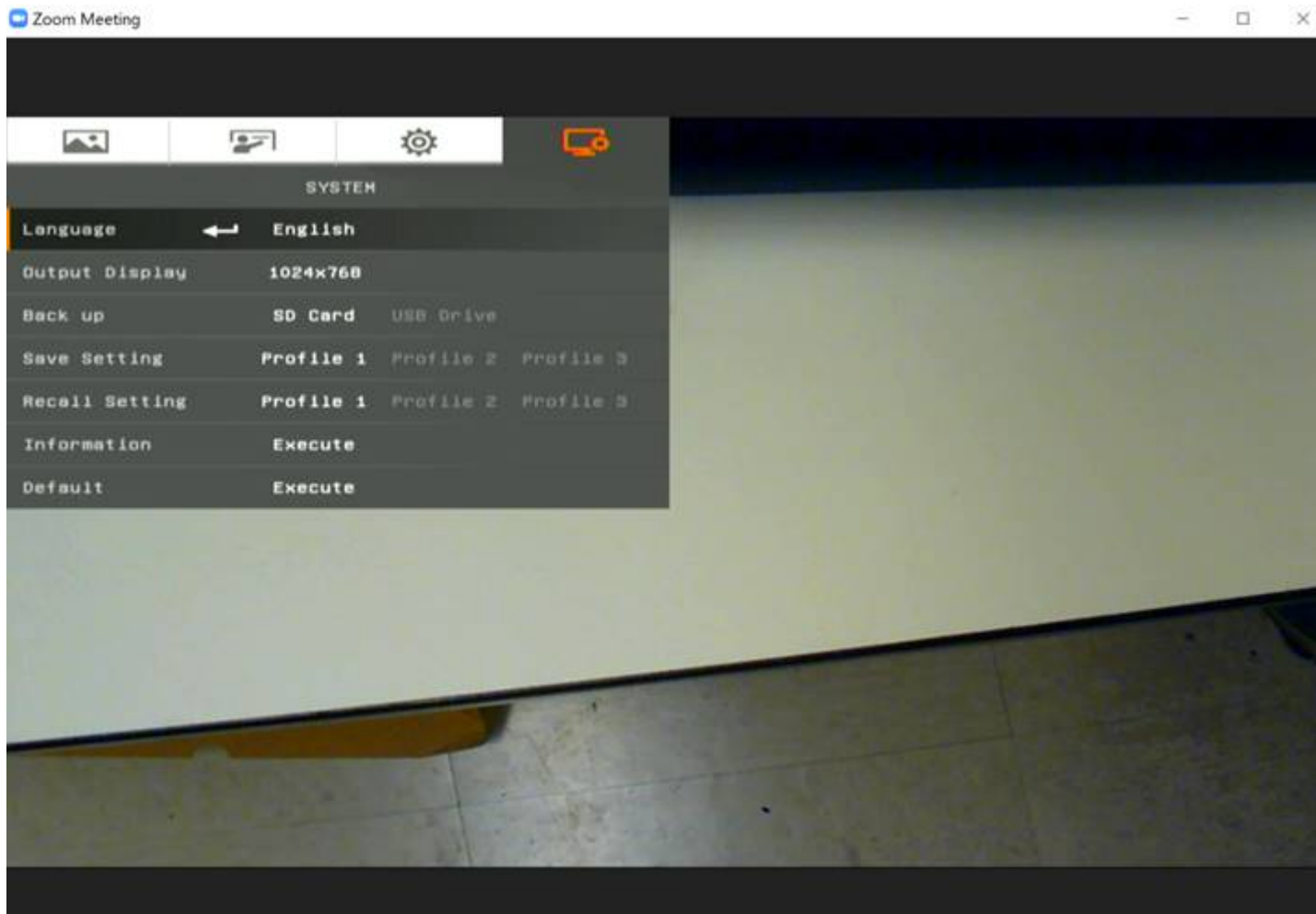
Connection (refer to image below):

1. Plug the VGA out of the document camera to the VGA IN of the VGA to HDMI converter
 - a. The VGA to HDMI converter needs to be powered by USB. Provide power by plugging the mini USB cable from the converter to your PC (takes up one USB port)
2. Plug the HDMI OUT of the VGA to HDMI converter to the HDMI IN of the HDMI to USB converter
3. Plug HDMI to USB converter into your PC

4. Launch application (Zoom, Skype, Team, Google Meet) and select “USB Camera” as your camera source to bring in the USB feed
