 When connecting PTZ Link with Sennheiser TCC2, PTZ Link won't capture the channel 8(Azimuth 315°) when feeding a far-end signal into TCC2 via Dante.

#### Notes

 To perform best performance of virtual camera, the AVer virtual camera resolution is limited to minimum 720p.

- When enabling human tracking on PTZ Link, user may experience random expected camera zoom in/out.
  - This will be fixed in camera firmware, reference the following list of fixed versions:
  - PTC310/ PTC310N/ PTC310U/ PTC310UN/ PTC330/ PTC330N/ PTC330U
     0.0.0000.45 and later
  - PTC330UV2/PTC320UNV2/PTC320UV2/PTC310UV2/PTC310HWV2 0.1.0000.35 and later
- In scenarios when switching to Zoom Rooms from Zoom Rooms Admin, PTZ Link may not be restarted.
  - The keyboard short Alt+Tab resolves the issue. (A fix will be provided in the next version.)
- When using Zoom Rooms, after tapping sections out of the PTZ Link GUI, PTZ Link user interface will disappear.
  - To resolve this, use Alt+Tab to switch back to PTZ Link. (A fix will be

provided in the next version).
